- Gold slides more than 2% as U.S. Treasury yields rise
- Oil Down, Investors Look to OPEC+ Meeting for Production Stance
- Copper jumps to 9-1/2 year high on inflation fears

## Precious metals

Gold prices fell as much as 2.2% to a near one-week low on Thursday as a surge in U.S. Treasury yields and better-than-expected economic data out the United States dented demand for the safe-haven metal. Spot gold was down 1.8% at \$1,772.86 per ounce at 01:49 p.m. ET (1849 GMT), after earlier touching its lowest since Feb. 19 at \$1,765.06.U.S. gold futures settled down 1.3% to \$1,775.40.

### NYMEX Oil

Oil was down Friday morning in Asia, ending the week on a low note. The global market tightened as investors await an Organization of the Petroleum Exporting Countries and allies (OPEC+) meeting scheduled for the following week. Brent oil futures were down 0.30% to \$65.92 by 9:10 PM ET (2:10 AM GMT) and WTI futures were down 0.41% to \$63.27. The OPEC+ meeting will be closely watched for any changes made by the cartel to production levels as prices continue to recover.

### **Base Metals**

Copper prices surged to their highest in almost a decade on Thursday as investors scrambled to buy metals as a hedge against potential inflation from ongoing central bank stimulus. Three-month copper on the London Metal Exchange had climbed 1.6% to \$9,457 a tonne by 1715 GMT, after hitting its highest since August 2011 at \$9,617. Copper is about 6% below its record high of \$10,190 a tonne hit in February 2011.
