Market Review

US: U.S. stocks closed higher Friday, booking weekly gains with support from data confirming an economic recovery from the coronavirus pandemic, despite inflation running at its highest annual rate in about 13 years.

Asia: Asian stocks were mixed Monday in holiday-thinned trading as investors prepared for a key Federal Reserve meeting later in the week.

India: The Sensex closed at 52,474.76, up 174.29 points, or 0.33% ,while the Nifty was at 15,799.35, up 61.60 points, or 0.39%. Auto, IT, metal and pharma stocks led Nifty gains. Among broader indices, BSE midcap and smallcap indices closed 0.14% and 0.40% higher, respectively. **Market is expected to open gap down and likely to witness profit booking during the day.**

Global Economy: Mexican industrial output fell m-o-m for the first time in 11 months in April, even as activity rose by a record margin from the previous year thanks to a rebound from a pandemic-induced contraction in 2020. Compared with March, industrial output dropped 0.2% in seasonally adjusted terms as expansion in the mining sector was offset by declines in manufacturing, construction and energy.

Britain's recovery from the COVID-19 pandemic sped up in April as lockdown measures eased, with the fastest monthly growth since July leaving output a record 27.6% higher than a year earlier, when the virus was rampant and lockdown tightest. Economic output rose by 2.3% month-on-month in April, marking the fastest growth since July, and slightly above the Reuters poll consensus for a 2.2% increase.

Vehicle sales in China fell 3% in May from the same month a year earlier, snapping a streak of 13 consecutive months of gains since April 2020. Overall sales in the world's biggest car market totaled 2.13 million vehicles in May.

Commodities: Oil prices held near multi-year highs on Monday, underpinned by an improved outlook for demand as increased COVID-19 vaccinations help lift travel curbs.

Gold prices fell to a more than one-week low on Monday, weighed down by a stronger dollar as focus turns to the Federal Reserve policy meeting this week with recent spikes in U.S. consumer prices seen as a temporary blip.

Currency: The U.S. dollar held steady against major currencies on Monday, after posting its biggest weekly gain in more than a month, as traders closed short positions ahead of a Federal Reserve policy meeting this week.

DLF targets 30 pc growth in sales bookings to Rs 4,000 cr during FY22; to launch 8 mn sq ft area

DLF aims a 30 % jump in its sales bookings to Rs 4,000 crore this fiscal, as the company expects a rise in housing demand despite the COVID-19 pandemic.The company will launch various projects, comprising 8 million square feet of saleable area, to tap this growing demand for residential properties, especially those built by trusted developers. Saint-Gobain eyes up to Rs 1,000 crore revenue from housing solutions business in 3 to 5 years

Saint-Gobain India, which has entered into the B2C segment in the housing solutions business, is looking at a revenue in the range of Rs 750 crore to Rs 1,000 crore in three to five years.The company expects the housing solutions segment to be a Rs 15,000 to 20,000 crore market in around five years and to have a minimum of 5 per cent market share, said B Santhanam, Saint-Gobain CEO (APAC and India), Chairman and MD Saint-Gobain India. ITC to expand Welcomhotel brand to 25 hotels

The Rs 45,000 crore hospitality arm of ITC, said it was planning to increase the number of properties under the brand Welcomhotel to 25 in a year's time from 19 now. (ET)

ZEE to launch OTT service ZEE5 in America on June 22

ZEE is set to launch its video streaming service, ZEE5, in the US market on June 22. While the service was launched in Indian three years back, ZEE had to wait for the US launch as its existing distribution contract with US pay-TV operator Dish Network didn't allow the broadcaster to launch a digital offering till March 2021. Economy News

Base effect drives up IIP growth in April

The index of industrial production (IIP) hit 126.6 in April, marking a 134.4% surge from a year before, driven primarily by a favourable base. A Covid-induced lockdown in April 2020 had substantially hampered industrial production (IIP had crashed by 57.3%). The government released only the index readings for April on Friday, without announcing the growth rates, as comparisons with April 2020 data are fraught with risks of erroneous interpretations. The government also revised up IIP growth to 24.1% for March from 22.4% reported earlier and to -0.6% for January from -0.9%. Moreover, the latest index readings for capital goods, consumer durables and infrastructure goods were lower than the April 2019 levels, but those for consumer non-durables, primary goods and intermediate goods remained higher. (FE)

Forex reserves cross USD 600 bn mark for first time

The country's foreign exchange reserves crossed the USD 600 billion mark for the first time after increasing by USD 6.842 billion in the week ended June 4. The reserves surged to a record USD 605.008 billion in the reporting week, helped by a rise in foreign currency assets (FCA), a major component of the overall reserves. In the reporting week, FCA jumped by USD 7.362 billion to USD 560.890 billion. Gold reserves declined by USD 502 million to USD 37.604 billion. (FE)


